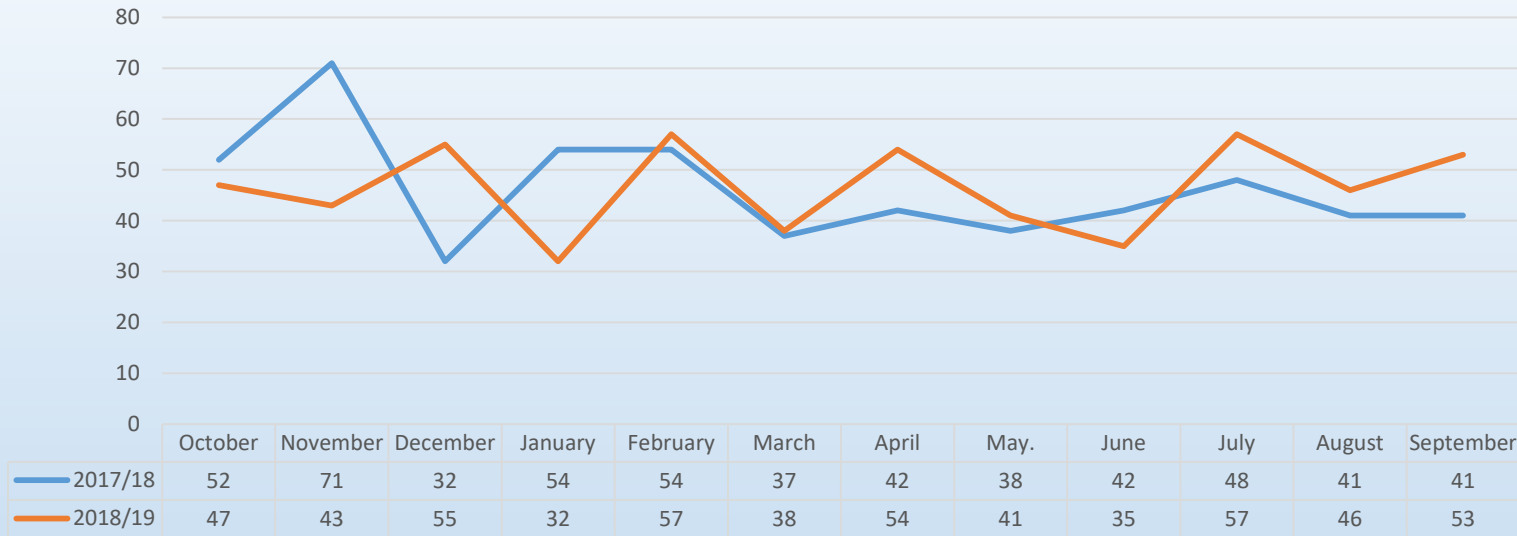

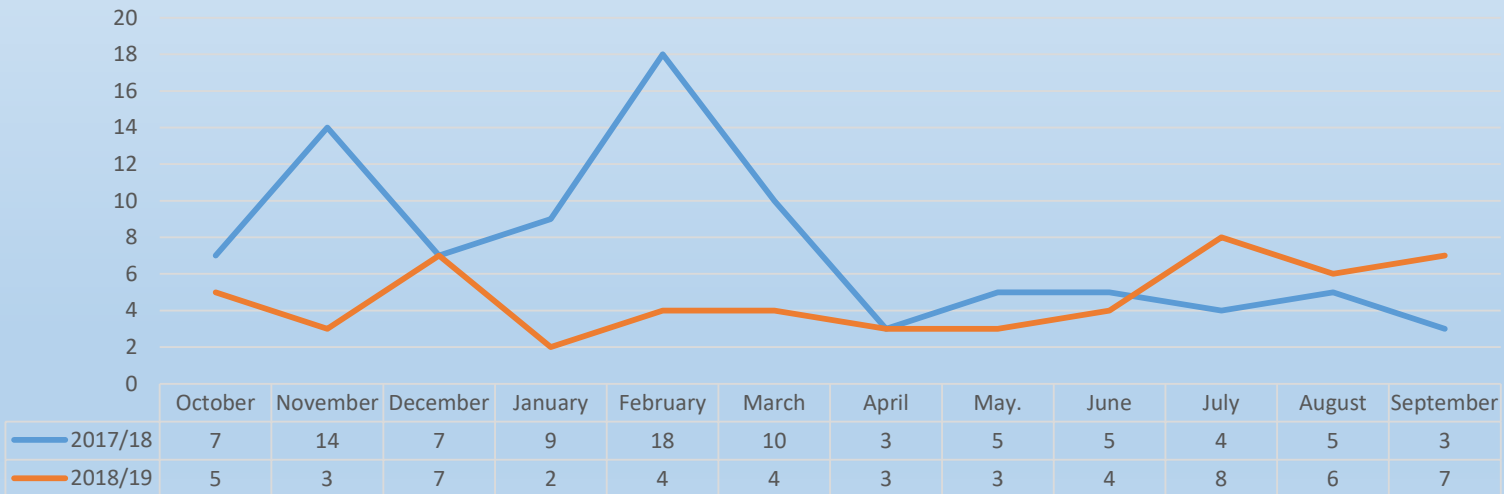

Knife Crime Offences & Knife Crime with Victim Under 25

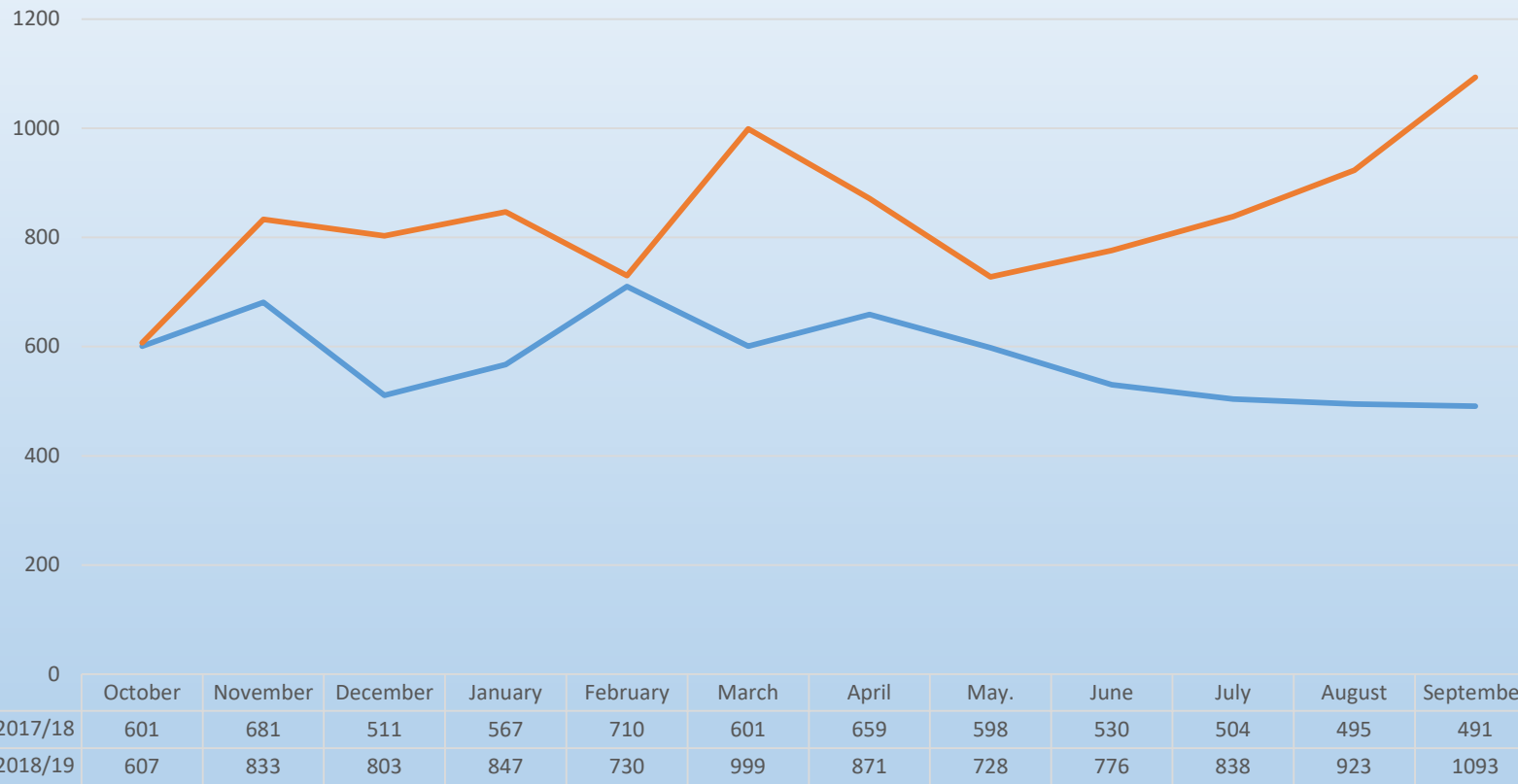


- Total knife crime increased to 558 offences for the year ending Sept 2019 from 552 offences for the previous year. An increase of 6 offences



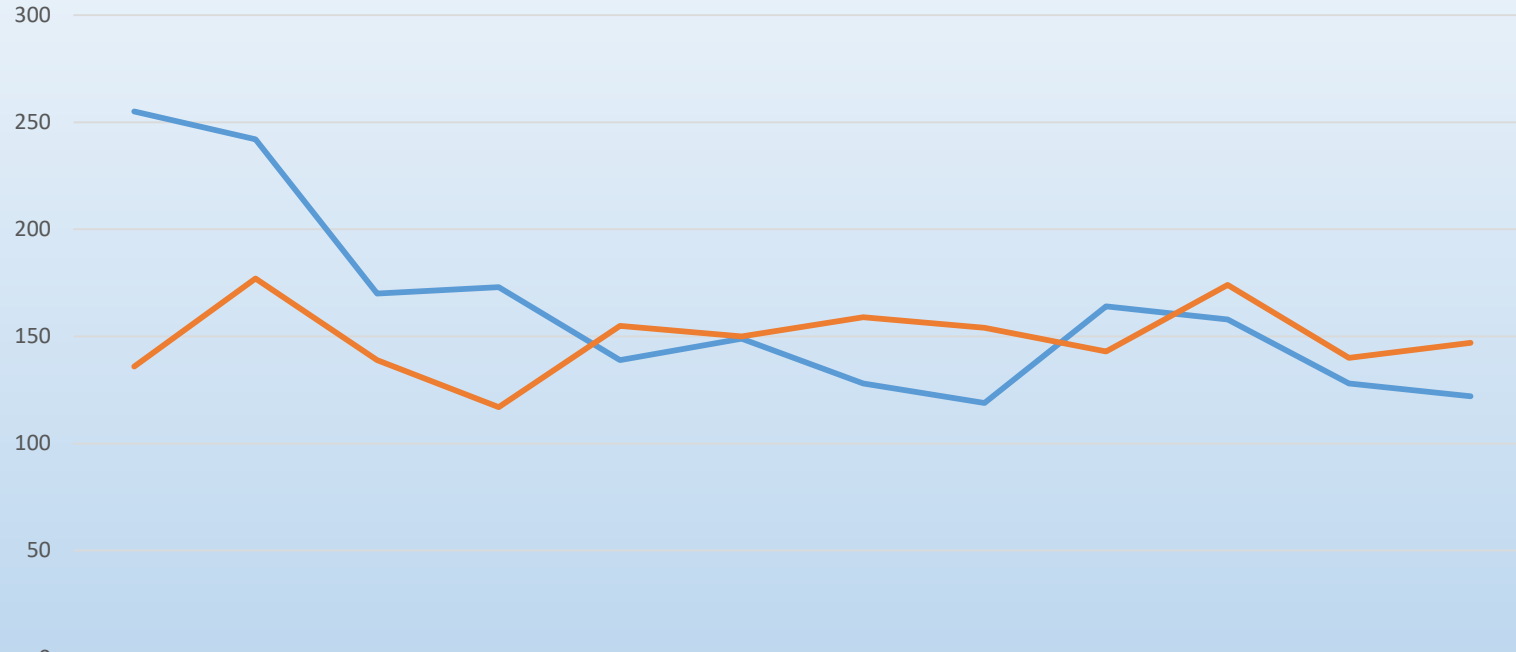
- The number of knife crimes with a victim under 25 decreased in the year to Sept 2019 to 56 offences from 90 offences for the previous year. A fall of 34 offences.

Stop and Search



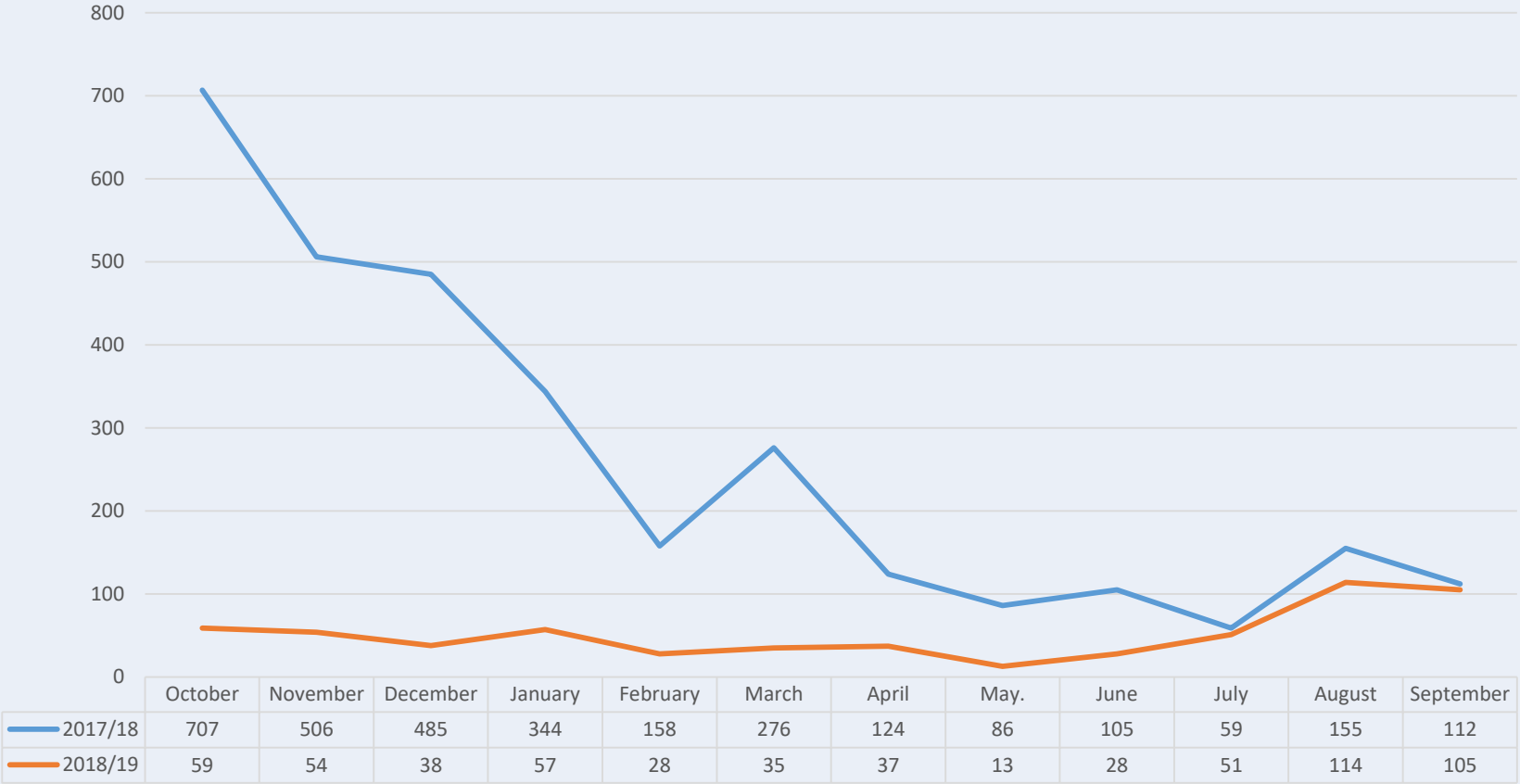
- The number of people that were stopped and searched in Camden in the year to Sept 2019 increased to 10,048 from 6948 in the year ending Sept 2018. An increase of 3100 searches.

Robbery



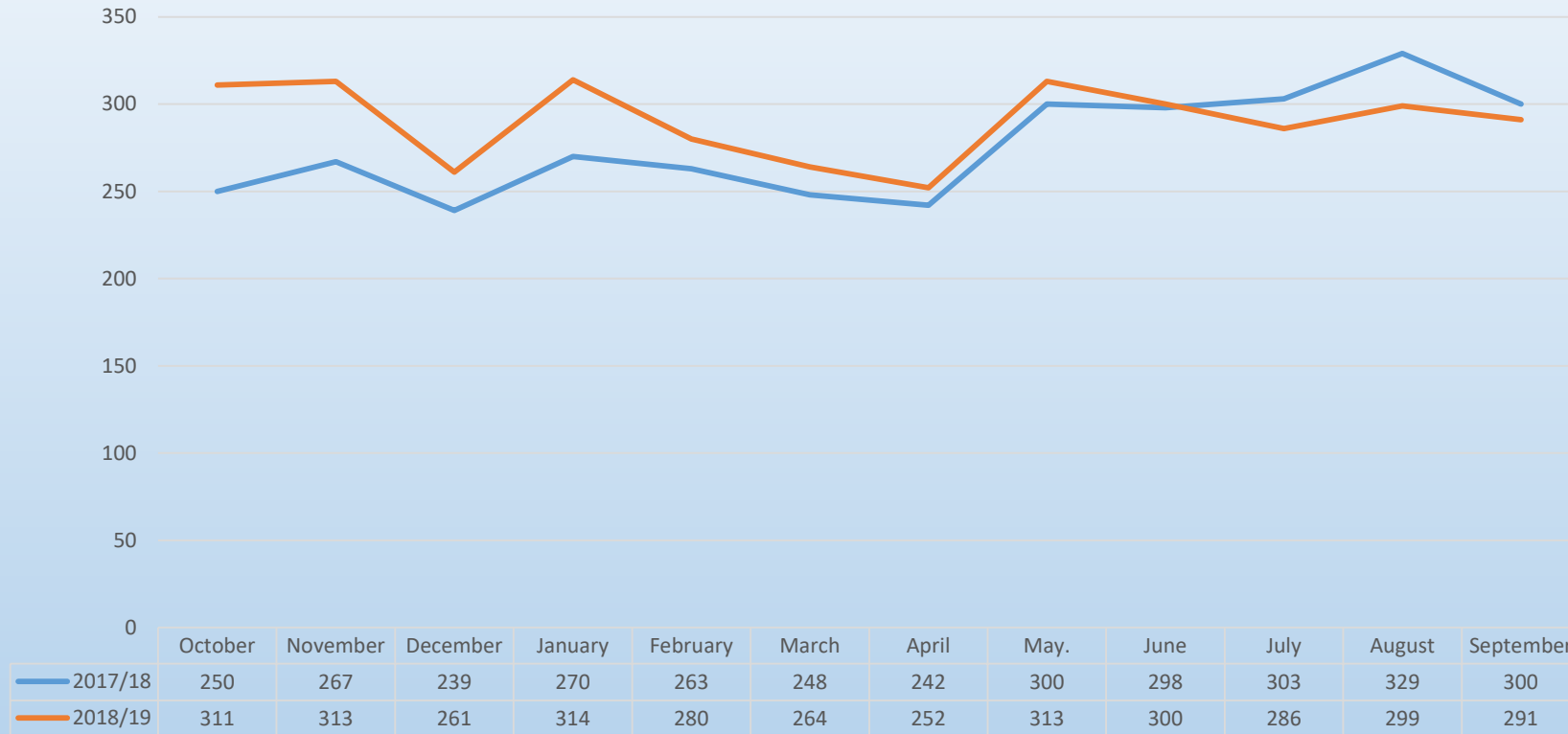
- The number of robberies decreased to 1,791 crimes for the year ending Sept 2019 from 1,947 offences for the previous year. A decrease of 156 offences.

Moped Enabled Crime



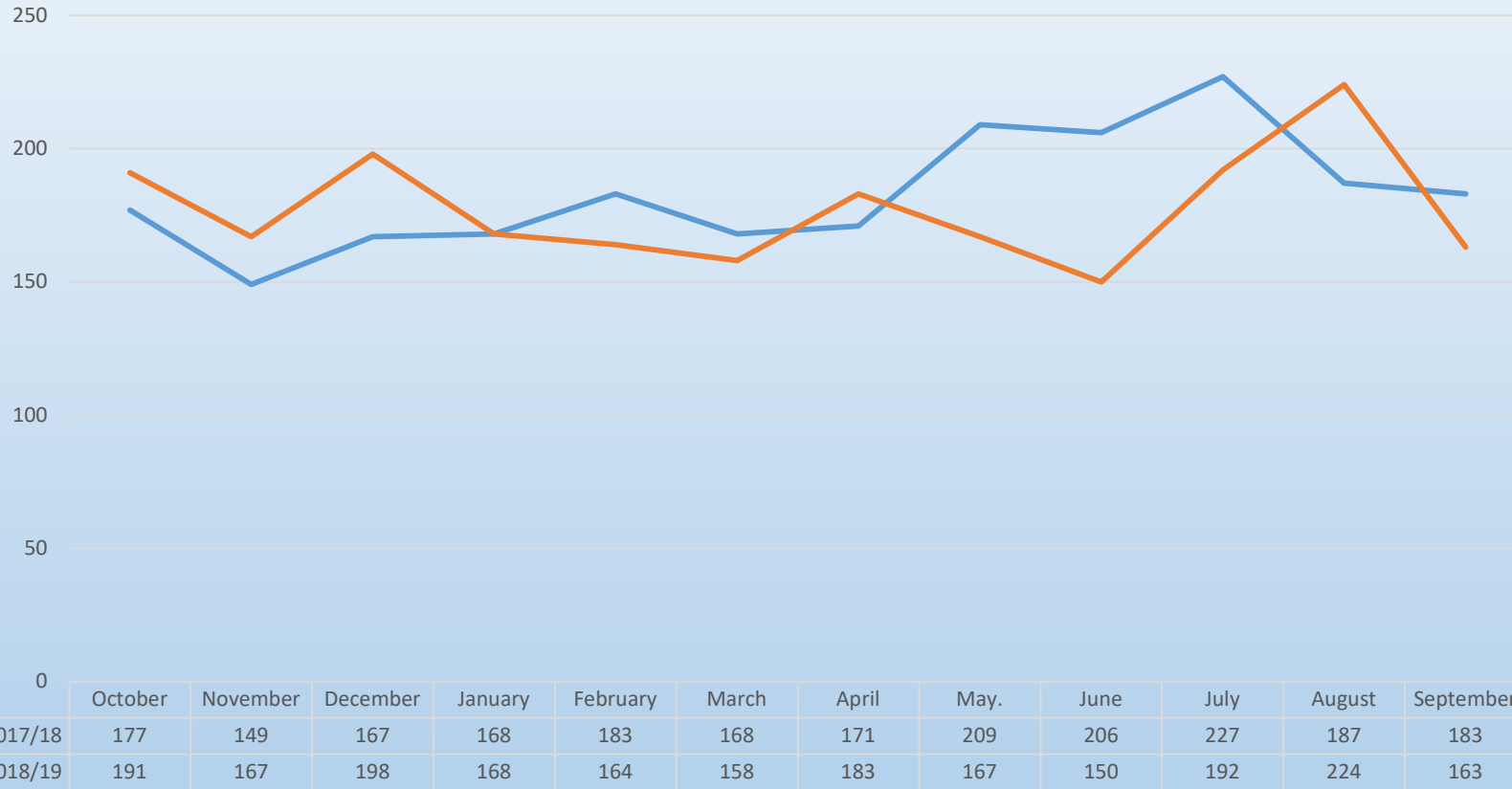
- Moped Enabled Crime decreased to 619 offences for the year ending Sept 2019 from 3117 in the previous year. A decrease of 2498 crimes.

Residential Burglary.



- The number of residential burglaries increased to 3484 crimes for the year ending Sept 2019 from 3309 offences for the year ending Sept 2018. An increase of 175 offences.

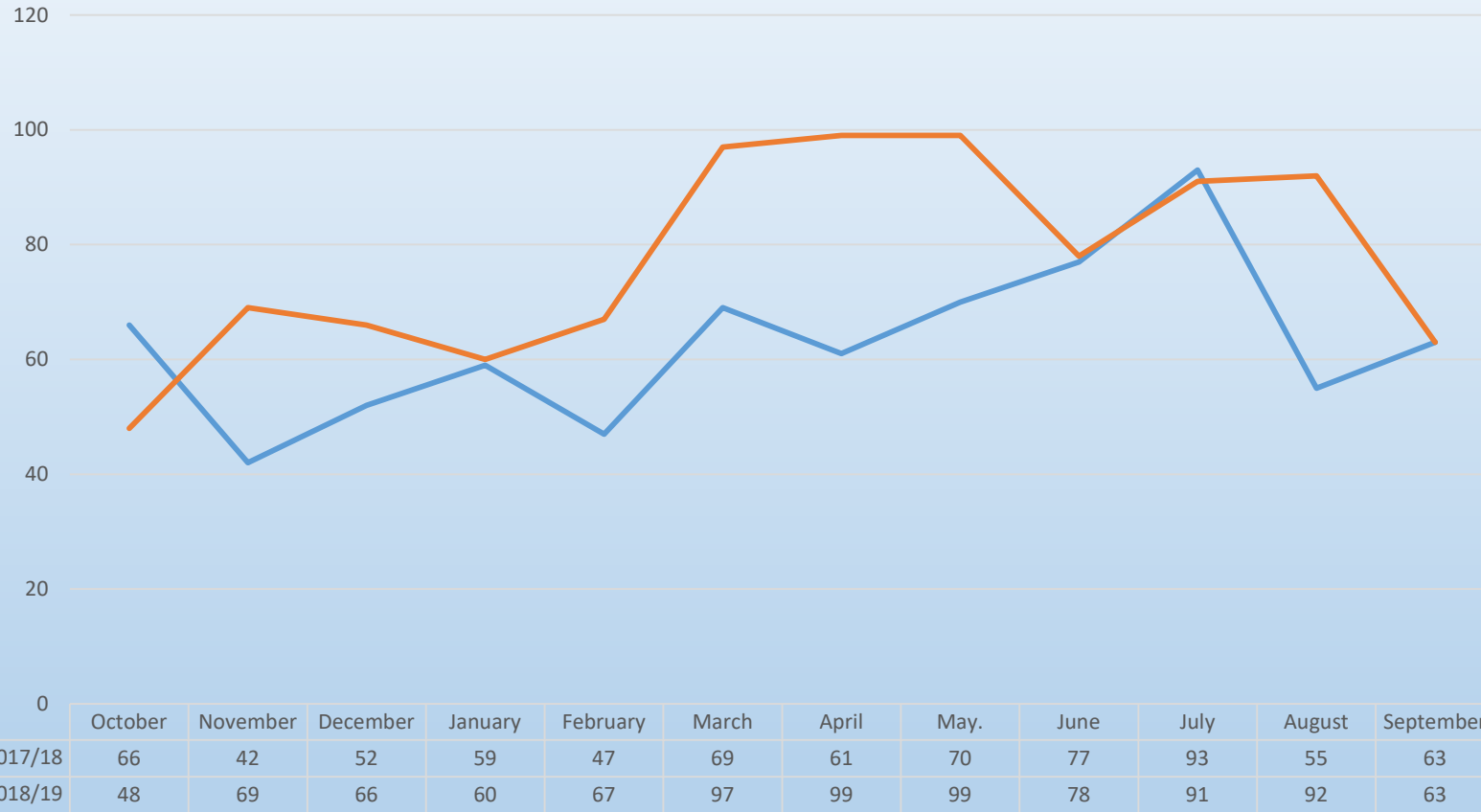
Domestic Abuse.



- The number of reported crimes in relation to Domestic Abuse decreased to 2,125 crimes for the year ending Sept 2019 from 2,195 offences for the year ending Sept 2018. An decrease of 70 offences.

Hate Crime (excluding DA).

- The number of recorded hate crimes increased to 929 crimes for the year ending Sept 2019 from 754 offences for the year ending Sept 2018. An increase of 175 offences.
